Members of Zebra Generation have rights and obligations inferred from general CBO principles and Ugandan laws governing such organizations.

MEMBER RIGHTS

- Right to Participate: Members have the right to participate in decision-making processes, vote on key issues, and hold leadership positions within the organization.
- ® Right to Information: Members are entitled to access information about the organization's activities, finances, and governance structure.
- ® Right to Freedom from Discrimination: Members have the right to be treated fairly and without discrimination based on their background, gender, or any other characteristic.
- ® Right to Benefit from Services: Members can access services and benefits provided by the organization, such as training, capacity-building initiatives, and advocacy support.

MEMBER OBLIGATIONS

- Adherence to the Organization's Mission and Vision: Members are expected to uphold and promote the organization's mission, vision, and values.
- Participation in Activities: Members are encouraged to actively participate in the organization's activities, meetings, and decision-making processes.
- Payment of Membership Fees: Members may be required to pay membership fees or dues to support the organization's operations.
- Accountability: Members are expected to be accountable for their actions and decisions within the organization.
- Respect for Fellow Members: Members are expected to treat fellow members with respect and dignity, promoting a positive and inclusive organizational culture.
